# Can govt defy cabinet advice on House?

New Delhi: As Rajasthan Governor MLAs demand summoning of the state assembly a reading of the Supreme Court's rulings do not leave much scope for the Governor to exercise his discretion over the state cabinet has recommended convening of session.  
Question whether the Governor, in exercise of his powers under Article 174, could defy or delay advice of the Ashok Gehlot government are answered by the view that this can be done only when the government's majority is in doubt.

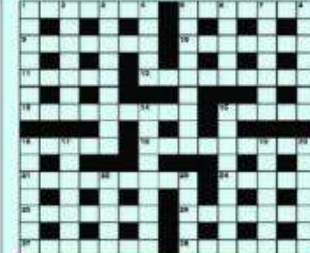
its last sitting in one session and the date appointed for its first sitting in the next session." Does this mean the Governor has discretion to summon the House as per his assessment, disregarding the advice of the council of ministers headed by the CM?

A five-judge bench of the SC in Nabam Biju Judgment (July 2018) scrutinised the provision in the draft constitution and its final version as Article 174 and ruled, "Where satisfied in concluding that the governor can summon, prorogue and dissolve the House only on the aid and advice of the council of ministers with the chief minister as the head. And not on his own." Further, it said, "The consent of the council of ministers is a significant explanation to its terse interpretation of the governor's powers on summoning the House. It said, "We are of the view that in ordinary circumstances during the period when the chief minister and his council of ministers enjoy the confidence of the majority of the House, the power vested with the governor under Article 174, to summon, prorogue and dissolve the

House), must be exercised in consonance with the aid and advice of the chief minister and his council of ministers. In the above situation, he is precluded from taking an individual call on the issue at his own will, or in his own discretion. However, "In a situation where the governor has reasons to believe that the chief minister and his council of ministers have lost the confidence of the majority of the House, it is open to the governor to require the chief minister and his council of ministers to prove their majority in the House by a floor test. Only in a situation where the government in power on the holding of such a floor test is seen to have lost the confidence of the majority would it be open to the governor to exercise the powers vested with him under Article 174 at his own, and without any aid and advice."

Congress leaders staged demonstrations at all 33 district headquarters during the day, accusing BJP of attempting to topple an elected government through horse-trading of MLAs. At the CLP meeting held in the Jalpur hotel where Congress MLAs have been centralised since July 23, Kataria said, "In a democracy, the key aspect is who has majority. When the majority is with us and we want to go to the floor of the House, it is beyond comprehension why we should be stopped from asking for an assembly session."  
"Our fight can be turning point in saving democracy in India," he said.  
BJP spokesperson Randeep Singh Sagarwal was quoted as saying at the CLP meeting that such current actions would be remembered for how "100 people" crushed the rebellion led by sacked deputy chief minister Sachin Pilot.
